D: Dispatch
C1: Initial Female Caller
C2: 2nd Male Caller
C3: 3rd Female Caller
P: Stillwater Police Officers

D: 911 emergency.
C1: Yes, I need an ambulance.
D: To what address?
C1: Um, 1451 South Greeley Street Apartment #110 and it's going to the VA in Minneapolis.
D: Okay, and can you verify the phone number?
C1: Uh, here?
D: Yes, that you're
C1: My phone number
D: Calling from.
C1: Here is
D: Tell me exactly what happened.
C1: Oh, my husband is, is suppose to go to the VA and he's kind of really out of his mind. He's sittin' in the back with a cane and he's not, uh, he's not gonna help us get him ready so we can take him, so
D: Okay.
C1: It isn't going to be possible for us to transport him.
D: Okay, and why is he supposed to go there?
C1: He needs nutrition build up. He's, he, he's dehydrated, he's gonna, suppose to have a very complicated surgery in a couple weeks, but he's, he's out of his mind right now.
D: What does he have or is he delusional or
C1: Uh, he's no, he has
D: What do you mean out of his mind?
C1: He's, uh, probably due to the fact that he's dehydrated and hasn't had anything to eat, he, they need to bui-build up his nutrition and his hydration and, uh, they're expecting him for admission.
Unknown Person: (In background) Yes
D: Is he gonna be combative?
C1: I certainly hope not, but he hit me in the back with a cane and I'm not gonna try to, uh, get him to put his clothes on anymore.
D: How old is he?
C1: 62.
D: I just have a couple questions I need to ask you.
C1: Okay.
D: Is he completely alert?

(Inaudible talking in the background)

C1: No, no, he's not, he's not really alert. Hold on just a second, hold on just a second.

D: Okay.

C1: Let me take a, let me take a look at him. Put your shoes on.

(Inaudible talking in the background)

C1: I, oh, I have somebody on the phone here now JERRY. Okay, were you, let me, come out here and let me put the shoe on.

(Inaudible talking in the background)

D: What's wrong with him?

C1: He's got two aneurisms and

D: Okay

C1: And his aortic aneur-, he's got two aortic aneurisms.

D: Alright, just

C1: And they're needing to do surgery on him, but they need to build up his nutrition and his hydration.

D: Is he changing color at all?

C1: Pardon me?

D: Is he changing color at all?

C1: Uh, no, that's not the problem.

D: Okay.

C1: The problem is getting

D: Fever?

C1: Yea-yeah, that's not the problem. If I could just get, if he'll just let me help him get dressed.

D: Yep, I just have to ask you these quick questions, okay? Does he have

C1: Okay.

D: A fever?

C1: No.

D: Coughing?

(Inaudible talking in the background)

C1: No.

D: Sore throat?

C1: Okay, hold on, I'm coming JERRY, I'm coming.

D: Sore throat?

C1: No, no.

D: Body aches? Runny or stuffy nose?

C1: No, none of that.

D: Diarrhea? Vomiting?

C1: No.

D: Chills or sweats?

C1: Non-none of

D: Headaches?

C1: Uh, oop, he probably has a little headache.

(Male talking in the background)

C1: Okay, he doesn't have a headache. Here, you wanna tell 'em you don't have any headache and not put your shoe on.

C2: Hello?

D: Hi, what's your name?

C2: PROPPS, what's yours?

D: My name is Kim. We're gonna send someone there to help you, okay?

C2: No.

D: No, you don't want anyone? Can I talk to TRUDY?

C2: (Inaudible) I, I'm going to get help and going to get help by myself.

D: Okay.

C1: (In background) Tell her I've just about got it.

C2: She's just about got it.

D: Okay, can I talk to her real quick?

C2: Yes, you can, just a moment.

C1: (In background) Just about ... uh

C2: (In background) Just a moment (Inaudible)

(Inaudible female talking in the background)

C1: I got, okay, I've got (Inaudible)

D: Okay, my partner's gonna get help started. I don't want you to let him have anything to eat or drink.

C1: Right.

D: It

C1: He can't have anything to eat or drink.

D: It might make him sick.

C1: But, but he is also, he, he is strictly a DNR.

D: Okay, do not

C1: Resuscitate.

D: Okay.

C1: No resuscitation.

D: Okay.

C1: Um, but we, we, we're gonna put him in the car here and take him to the VA, we, he's dressed now, so

D: So, you do not want me-us to have an ambulance come?

C1: No, I, no, I don't think you'll have to do that.

D: Okay, so you want me to cancel the ambulance?

(Inaudible talking in the background)

C1: Okay, hold on, hold on.

C2: Hello? What are you, what are you talking about now?

D: I need to talk to TRUDY.

C2: Okay, just a moment, (Inaudible) just a minute, TRUDY, come (Inaudible talking in the background) here, come, come TRUDY. (Inaudible talking continues in the background)

TRUDY, if I were to do anything, I'd do it to, to you now. I'd do it to you now.

Call cuts out for approximately five seconds.

C2: I have (Inaudible) myself, not you. (Inaudible talking in the background) Yes ...

D: Can I talk to your wife?

C2: Yes, you can. (Inaudible female talking in the background) Oh, God, what a mess you've made (Inaudible)

C1: (In background) I'm not gonna hurt you
(Inaudible talking in background)

Call cuts out for approximately five seconds again.

C1: (In background) I'm letting go of you! (Inaudible talking in the background) I, I'm letting go of you, don't (crying)!

C3: No, JERRY!

(Popping sound then screaming)

C3: Call 911! (Screaming continues and someone crying/moaning) Call 911! (Moaning continues and inaudible talking in the background) Call 911!

D: Christy, those Stillwater guys need to step it up.

(Moaning continues in the background)

C3: He shot her, are you on the phone?

D: Yes, help's coming as fast as they can, okay? Is she injured?

C3: She is very injured. He shot her in the back.

D: He shot her?

C3: Yes.

D: He has a gun right now?

C3: He does. I'm dragging her into the hallway.

(Moaning in the background)

D: Christy, did you copy that? Does he still have

(Moaning continues in the background)

D: Ma'am?

C3: I know you're hurt, I'm comin'.

(Moaning continues in the background)

Unknown Male: What happened?

C3: He shot her.

D: Ma'am, where is the gun right now?

C3: It's in his hands, she's in the hall.

D: Where are you?

C3: I'm in the hall. He is in the apartment by himself. The door is shut. He is armed. (Heavy breathing) Do you understand me?

C1: Uh, yeah (Inaudible)

C3: Okay, help is coming.

D: Everyone's coming as fast as they can. Where was she shot?

C3: In the back. I can't see it.

(Moaning continues in the background)

D: She's still conscious?

C3: She is conscious. , stay with me.

D: Ma'am?

C3: I'm here.

D: Okay, is there any serious bleeding?

C3: I'm sure that there is. It's in the back.

D: Is she completely alert?

C3: No. , can you open your eyes and look at me? ' Look at me. Yep, stay with me, I'm right here.

D: Tell, uh, ma'am, everyone's already on their way, okay? They should be there shortly, just stay on the phone with me and don't hang up.

C3: Okay, I'm not hanging up.

D: He's still in the apartment with a gun, correct?

C3: He is in the apartment with a gun.

D: Okay, is completely alert right now?

C3: No, she is not even close to it.

D: Do you have something that you can put on the wound?

C3: The wound is in her back and she's laying on her back.

D: Okay.

C3: Do you want me to roll her over? squeeze my hand.

D: I, I just want you to stay on the phone with me, okay?

C3: Squeeze my hand. I'm on, I'm, I'm here.

D: Are you just right outside the apartment?

(Moaning in the background)

C3: Okay, she is bleeding all the way through. It looks like it's a through and through.

D: Just stay on the phone with me, okay?

C3: Um, I, there, the help is on the way. She was on the phone with 911.

(Inaudible female talking in the background)

C3: Can you open the door?

(Inaudible female talking in the background)

C3: I want you to stay with me. look at me, look at me. Yep, right here,

D: Ma'am, what's your

C3: Right here

D: What's your first name?

C3: My name is and this is

D: Okay, everyone's comin' (Inaudible)

C3: He's in there and he is armed.

D: Everyone's comin' as fast as they can, okay?

(Moaning in the background)

C3: I'm right here. It's okay.

P: (In background) Police Department!

(Moaning continues in the background)

C3: I'm right here.

P: (In background) Put that gun down! Put it down! Put it down! Drop it! (Inaudible) Drop it right now!

C3: I'm right

(Numerous popping sounds in the background)

C3: I'm shot.

D: What?

C3: I'm shot, it went through the wall, I'm shot.

D: You just got shot?

C3: Yes, it went through the wall. I'm not sure if, I'm, I'm not sure if I just got splatter

(Inaudible talking in the background)
P: (In background) Brad, you okay? You okay?
(Inaudible talking continues in the background)
D: Ma'am, were you hit?
C3: Um, I, the bullet is not in me, but I'm definitely bleeding.
(Inaudible talking in the background)
D: Okay, listen to me.
C3: The bullet came through a wall and hit
D: Okay.
C3: My arm and it is on the floor.
(Inaudible talking continues in the background)
D: Okay.
Unknown Person: Where's the suspect?
C3: In there with the two officers. It came through the wall.
(Inaudible talking in the background continues)
Unknown Person: (Inaudible) There were shots (Inaudible) she's shot too.
C3: I'm shot in the arm. I don't think it's bad. The bullet is not in me. Um, needs help
though, she's struggling.
(Inaudible talking in the background)
D: Ma'am, just stay
C3: She's struggling, please help her!
D: Stay on the phone with me, okay?
C3: Okay.
D: Everyone's coming.
C3: Okay. ?
D: Ma'am, I need to know where the officers are.
C3: Get ya outta your jacket? Can I, can I remove her jacket? She's asking me to.
(Inaudible talking in the background)
D: Ma'am?
C3: Yes, I'm here.
D: Where are the officers?
C3: The officers, there's three officers in the apartment.
D: Okay, they're in the apartment with
C3: With my, it's
D: (In background) The The got the gun, the
outside (Inaudible) out in the hallway with who was shot in the back (Inaudible)
(Inaudible talking in the background)
C3: And I'm in the arm. It came through the wall. Oop, sorry. Okay, the officers are with
